

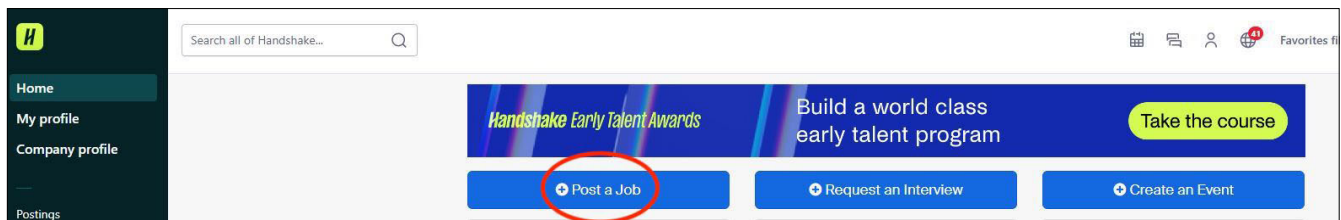
ADVERTISE ON-CAMPUS STUDENT JOBS

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BENEFITS OF FEDERAL WORK STUDY

Federal Work Study (FWS) is a **a federally-funded financial aid program that subsidizes a portion of student earnings**. The program is dependent on the student applying for financial aid through the FAFSA and qualifying based on their financial need. The subsidy is set each year based on projected spending, and can change. For the 2023-2024 award year, the split is 70% federal funding, 30% departmental funding.

This **subsidy helps departments stretch their payroll dollars** while obtaining talented, part-time employees and, at the same time, helps students finance some of their educational expenses. Students **obtain transferable work skills and experience** which is essential in their post-graduation employment search. Many students develop good networking relationships with staff members who can provide excellent letters of recommendation or references for future jobs and education.

Each year more than 1500 students on campus qualify for this program, and nearly 1000 of them earn FWS funds.
